



Do you have a family history of breast or ovarian cancer?

You may be eligible for high risk screening if you are 30 to 69 years old and have a personal or family history of cancer. Ask your doctor or nurse practitioner for a referral to a genetics clinic if you have:

- ◆ Breast cancer before age 45
- ◆ Triple negative breast cancer before age 60

Or have a family member with:

- ◆ Breast cancer before age 35
- ◆ Invasive ovarian cancer at any age
- ◆ Two separate breast cancers
- ◆ Breast and ovarian cancer
- ◆ A mutation in a breast cancer gene
- ◆ Breast cancer and another relative with breast, ovarian, prostate or pancreatic cancer
- ◆ Breast cancer who was assigned male at birth
- ◆ Breast or ovarian cancer in Ashkenazi Jewish families
